Online seminar "Children's Rights: Research, Experience, Reflection" (Dedicated to World Children's Day)

On November 20, 2020, the entire international community celebrates *World Children's Day*. First year students (short-cycle training program) of the specialty "Preschool Education" of the Pedagogical Institute of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University while studying the course "Pedagogical Partnership" studied the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child, developed models for providing support to children and their parents regarding the observance of children's rights.

On this occasion, on November 18, 2020, an online seminar was held on the topic "Children's Rights: Research, Experience, Reflection" (dedicated to World Children's Day).

During the event, a discussion was held on the following topics: achievements of modern preschool education in familiarizing preschool children with their rights; children's rights and the role of adults in their protection; models of the pedagogical partnership of preschool teachers with parents in familiarizing children with their rights. Based on the results of the discussion, students identified possible challenges teachers face in familiarizing children with their rights and productive practices in familiarizing children with their rights.
