Information about the workshop held on May 16-17, 2018, at the University of Silesia in Katowice (Cieszyn, Poland)

In the framework of the project № 21720008 "Higher School Lecturer's Competencies in the Epoch of Changes" funded by the International Visegrad Fund and the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Kingdom of the Netherlands, on May, 16-17, 2018 scientific seminar-workshop was held in Cheshyn (University of Silesia in Katowice, Poland) participating representatives of all research teams of the partner countries: Ukraine, Poland, Slovakia, Czech Republic. The seminar workshop was attended by representatives of the research team from Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University: teachers of the Department of Theory and History of Pedagogy of Pedagogical Institute: head of the Department, doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, professor L. L. Khoruzha, and Melnychenko A. V., Candidate of Historical Sciences, associate professor, professor; Proshkin V. V., doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, associate professor, professor, Department of Information Technologies and Mathematical Sciences of the faculty of Informational Technologies and Management. They made presentations on the results of the study and participated in the discussion of methodological approaches of the study, results of diagnostic competencies of teachers in higher education carried out in partner countries. During the exchange of views, further research plan was coordinated, joint recommendations on the standardization activities of higher school teachers and identified further steps to promote the project results.
