

Guest Lecture "Academic Culture of a Researcher in the Educational Process as a Component of National Security"

On November 24, 2021, a guest online lecture on "Academic Culture of a Researcher in the Educational Process as a Component of National Security" was held for applicants of the first (Bachelor's) and second (Master's) levels of higher education of the educational and professional program 013 Primary Education of the Pedagogical Institute of Borys Grinchenko Kyiv University.

Guest lecturers were: *Semenoh Olena Mykolaivna* - Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, Professor, Head of the Department of Ukrainian Language and Literature of Sumy State Pedagogical University named after A. S. Makarenko; *Vovk Myroslava Petrivna* - Doctor of Pedagogical Sciences, senior researcher, head of the Department of Content and Technologies of Pedagogical Education of the Ivan Zyazyun Institute of Pedagogical Education and Adult Education of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine; *Nadutenko Marharyta Volodymyrivna* - Candidate of Philological Sciences, senior researcher of the Department of Linguistics of the Ukrainian Language and Information Fund of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine, head of the Ukrainian Dictionary Studies Center.

The online lecture was devoted to discussing the following issues:

- review of national linguistic resources of the Ukrainian Language and Information Funds of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine as an effective tool in the formation of the academic culture of the researcher;
- peculiarities of the author's text formation as a component of the academic culture (on the example of preparing a scientific article for a professional journal);
- specifics of the culture of working with a scientific text;
- constructive dialogue between lecturers and researchers who relay the values of academic integrity in the educational process of higher education institutions.

The lecturers encouraged students to have a lively discussion because the issues raised are extremely relevant for modern higher pedagogical education.
